- The Household Financial Affordability Limit is used to access an applicant's affordability, the sum of the following two components. It is used to reflect and assess the applicant's affordability. It does not necessarily reflect the total financial resources available to the applicant. For more details, please contact the social worker:

- Household Assets Limit (including cash, savings deposits, investments and non-owner-occupied properties etc.)

- The government has published information regarding the ceiling of the household income for the past six months which cannot exceed 3.5 times the median over that period.

Service Charges

- Applicants who meet the above criteria and pass the financial assessment are eligible for a subsidy covering 70% of the basic residential fee. The applicant is only required to pay 30% of the fee, starting from approximately HK\$7,020 per month (basic rate). This fee includes rent, two routine ward rounds per month by the resident doctor, basic spiritual and social activities, meals, laundry service, basic nursing procedures, and related consumables (including incontinence care, blood glucose monitoring, simple wound care, nasogastric feeding care, oral care, stoma care, and continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) care, etc.).
- Other expenses are eligible for a 30% subsidy, and applicants are required to pay the remaining 70%. The actual amount depends on the level of nursing care, rehabilitation needs, and optional services chosen by the applicant. (For example, if the other expenses for the month amount to HK\$5,000, the applicant will pay 70% according to the co-payment ratio, i.e. HK\$3,500 per month.)

Remarks: The nursing care levels under this programme are classified as Basic, Moderate, High, and Enhanced. The monthly fee for the Basic level is HK\$23,400. Patients under this level will be accommodated in the SASHCC's Sister Annie Skau Block. For more details, please contact our staff.

This incorporates integrated medical care, nursing care, rehabilitation, and spiritual care for the frail elderly, long-term patients and those at the end-of-life.



Holistic and Quality Care Services

Haven of Hope Sister Annie Skau Holistic Care Centre (SASHCC) is committed to providing holistic care services for the elderly and patients with diverse needs. Our clinical services are led by experienced palliative care, geriatric, and orthopedic specialist doctors and nurses. The Centre also hosts resident physiotherapists and occupational therapists to provide rehabilitation support services. Additionally, our social workers and chaplains offer free spiritual care and community activities. Our multi-disciplinary team conducts comprehensive assessments for each resident, developing personalized care plans aimed at significantly improving their quality of life.



Our Centre comprises the Wah Wing Block and the Sister Annie Skau Block, offering a total of 100 beds in a variety of room options. These include family suites, private rooms, double rooms, and rooms for 4-6 persons. Designed for spaciousness and comfort, our nursing floors feature a terrace garden, living rooms, and dining halls, all aimed at creating a warm, tranquil, home-like environment. Other facilities include a rooftop garden, multi-purpose activity rooms, a family health resource corner, and a chapel cater to the physical, social, and spiritual needs of patients and their families.

Long Term Care Beds Programme for Christian Pastors/Pastors' Parents

To express gratitude for the work of pastors and missionaries, we have established the "Long Term Care Beds Programme for Christian Pastors/Pastors' Parents". This programme supports them and their families in addressing changing physical conditions and care needs. It is suitable for individuals whose physical condition is relatively stable and who require transitional, as well as long-term care.

Scope of Service

• Continuous Care Support

Facing changes in physical conditions (such as stroke, dementia, and other long-term illnesses), care needs may increase to a point where home care becomes challenging. This programme provides transitional care for patients who need long-term care services (with a maximum residential period of 5 years).

• Quality Medical Care

Resident doctors make regular rounds, working with the nursing team to provide patients with meticulous and personalized long-term care and medical support.

• Integrated Psycho-Social-Spiritual Care

Our psycho-social-spiritual team (consisting of chaplains and social workers) regularly provides pastoral care and emotional support. They also organize various social and recreational activities to enhance the quality of life for patients.

• Tranquil Environment

Our peaceful natural setting and comprehensive facilities allow residents to recuperate comfortably and tranquilly. Patients admitted through this programme will be arranged to stay in rooms accommodating 4 to 6 people.

Eligibility Requirement

Applicants must undergo assessment by our centre's social worker and meet all of the following criteria:

- The applicant (patient) must be*:
 - Current or retired full-time Christian pastor, missionary, chaplain, or someone who has resigned due to terminal illness, along with their spouse, or;
 - Parent or spouse's parent of a current or retired full-time Christian pastor, missionary, or chaplain.
- * Valid documentation of ministry is required upon application (regular updates are required if the stay extends beyond 1 year).
- Health Condition:
 - Relatively stable physical condition, and have needs ranging from transitional to long-term care.
- Financial Condition (applicable only to the "Long Term Care Beds Programme for Christian Pastors/Pastors' Parents"):
 - Passed the household financial assessment:
 1. The household financial assessment is primarily based on the income and assets of the applicant and all family members living together.
 2. If the combined total of the "assets" and "income in the past 6 months" of the applicant and all family members living together does not exceed the "household financial affordability limit", the applicant is eligible for admission (details provided in the next page).
